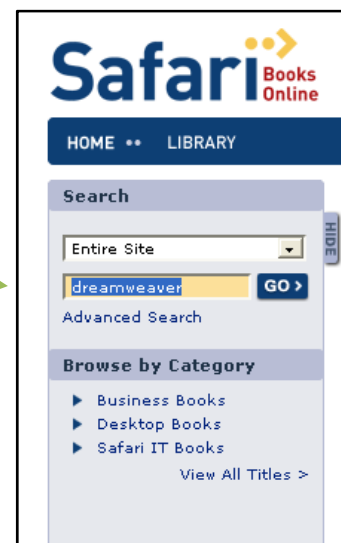
Off-campus access
